

The whole historic Art Deco vessel Daniel Adamson is available for hire for events in Liverpool and on the River Weaver in Cheshire, accommodating parties of up to 75 guests in style and comfort.

Number 15 on the Register of National Historic Ships, the Daniel Adamson was outfitted with Art Deco saloons and Promenade Decks in 1936 for hosting visiting dignitaries, diplomats and trade delegations. These spaces have been restored to their original high specification, with modern electrics and wifi incorporated discreetly into the original design.

The Promenade Deck comfortably seats 32 for an afternoon tea, or up to 48 for a talk, and the Art Deco saloon seats 20 for a talk or cabaret style set up. Guests tend to gather on the after deck, where there is a full bar, a clear view and a convivial atmosphere.


The venue lends itself to many different kinds of events, from business breakfasts and evening networking events, to wedding parties and milestone occasions.

THE SPACES ON BOARD THE DANNY








PROMENADE DECK

This covered area comfortably accommodates 32 for a sit down meal, afternoon tea, or workshop requiring group work, or 48 seated auditorium style for a talk or performance.

PROMENADE DECK




ART DECO SALOONS



OTHER AREAS

The Galley on the main deck to the rear of the vessel, which houses the bar, is always a pleasant place for people to gather, to enjoy the views out over the river or a conversation with a colleague or friend. The whole vessel is hired, which means that those interested can visit the wheelhouse, home to our original 1903 ship's wheel, or peep in at the Edwardian workings in the engine or boiler rooms (though sadly, insurance rules preclude us from inviting the public into these spaces).

Unique venue

The Danny has hosted King Fuad of Egypt, King Faisal of Iraq, Prince George of Denmark and countless trade, political and social gatherings. She is listed on the National Register of Historic Vessels and is part of the National Historic Fleet, the elite group of vessels identified as being of pre-eminent national or regional significance. And she is beautiful, a wonderful backdrop for photos, and a place that fosters conversation and connection.

Beautiful settings

Whether in the iconic Royal Albert Dock in Liverpool, or in the lush, pastoral surrounds of the River Weaver (a serene natural environment only 30 minutes from Liverpool), the view from The Danny is spectacular.

Friendly and expert crew

Excellent transport links

In Liverpool, the Danny can be reached by Merseyrail to James Street Station, or by any of the buses that operate to Liverpool One Bus Station. Either of these are 5 minutes walk from The Danny's berth in Royal Albert Dock. There is also plenty of parking around Royal Albert Dock and Liverpool One. At Sutton Weaver, the Danny is a 15 minute walk from Frodsham Station, or can be reached by car from the A56.

Registered charity

Choosing The Danny for your event means you are supporting our mission to keep The Danny for the nation, and supporting the work we do with schools, colleges, mental health and disability charities as well as local community organisations.

OUR LOCATIONS



RIVER MERSEY

In Liverpool, our berth is right at the centre of things in the historic Royal Albert Dock. The Danny was a part of the bustling economy of the historic port of Liverpool at the beginning of the twentieth century. It is very special to host an event on board at the centre of the cultural, business and tourism landscape of the twenty first century Royal Albert Dock.





RIVER WEAVER

The Danny's Berth at Sutton Weaver Swing Bridge is an oasis of calm just half an hour from Liverpool, between the market town of Frodsham and the industrial town of Runcorn, on the beautiful River Weaver. The River Weaver is one of Cheshire's hidden gems, and our berth is an idyllic setting, rich in natural and heritage interest.






CHARTERING THE DANNY IN STEAM

It is an extraordinary experience to sail on the historic waterways of the River Mersey, River Weaver and the Manchester Ship Canal on board the last remaining Mersey-built steamship in the country. It is impressive, moving, authentic and incomparable. We have been chartered by arts festivals, maritime organisations and luxury visitor experience companies, all of whom have been delighted with the experience.

It is a feat to bring into alignment the requirements of a 1903 steam vessel, tide times, lock and swing bridge operations on these historic waterways, and we are more likely to be able to accommodate requests made well in advance.





Our berths are Liverpool, Ellesmere Port, Sutton Weaver Swing Bridge and Anderton Boat Lift, Northwich, and we can arrange sailings between these berths and on the Manchester Ship Canal subject to the restrictions mentioned above.
